Dress Code

Ascot is a proud Independent Public School with a longstanding tradition of pride in our uniform and as such, strictly enforces this Dress Code Policy for all students enrolled at our school. Parents and carers enrol their children at this school on the understanding that the correct uniform will be worn at all times. Ascot State School students wear two uniforms – a Warm Weather Uniform and a Cool Weather Uniform. In addition, a sports uniform is to be worn on the day/s your child has Physical Education lessons and Gala Days.

Warm Weather Uniform

Years 1-6



- Ascot tartan dress
- Ascot tartan blouse with Ascot navy skirt
- Ascot navy shirt worn tucked into Ascot navy shorts
- Ascot navy short socks
- Plain black leather school shoes or trainers
- Ascot wide brimmed hat
- Year 6 - school tie for formal occasions or photos

Cool Weather Uniform

Years 1-6



- Ascot navy tunic with Ascot white short sleeved shirt and Ascot red knee high socks
- Ascot navy shirt worn tucked into Ascot navy shorts with Ascot grey knee high socks
- Ascot jumper
- Plain black leather school shoes or trainers or mary janes
- Ascot wide brimmed hat
- Year 6 - school tie

Prep & Sports Uniform

- Ascot sports shirt
- Ascot sports shorts
- Ascot navy short socks
- Black trainers
- Prep bucket hat or Years 1-6 wide brimmed hat
- Ascot jumper

Examples of
suitable shoes



- Navy back pack with the school emblem.
- Hair accessories must be red or navy ribbons. Shoulder length hair or longer must be tied back.
- Head coverings such as hijab, the yarmulke or a turban may be worn in navy.
- Watches, sleepers or studs may be worn. Smart watches may be worn but the mobile and other electronic devices policy and permission form must be completed.
- No other jewellery is permitted unless for cultural reasons with Principal approval.

Sporting Events

All students are allocated to a house group when they enrol at Ascot State School.

Our houses are: ● Henderson – yellow ● Ryan – red
● Lilley – blue ● Meibusch – green

During school sporting events such as the Cross Country, Athletics carnival or Swimming Carnival, all students are to wear the following uniform:

- Ascot wide brimmed school hat or bucket hat for Prep students
- Sports polo shirt in the house colour
- Ascot navy sports shorts
- Ascot navy short socks with black sneakers (unless wearing event specific shoes)
- Lycra or silicone caps in house colours must be worn for Swimming Carnivals

All requests for modifications to the Ascot State School Dress Code must be in writing to the Principal. Short or long term modifications will be granted on a case-by-case basis based on student health or religious requirements. Parents will be notified by the class teacher of non-compliance with the dress code and repeated non-compliance without Principal approval will incur consequences as outlined in our Responsible Behaviour Plan for Students.
