



ASCOT STATE SCHOOL FEES AND SERVICES 2022

Ascot State School provides free instruction, administration and facilities for students who are Australian citizens or permanent residents or children of Australian citizens or permanent residents at our school. In order to maintain the excellent educational outcomes of our students, we invite parents/carers to pay for the following fees to support our curriculum. We also invite parents to make a voluntary contribution to assist in maximising student engagement with digital devices.

Payment options include:

- BPOINT which is located on the link at the bottom of your invoice. (preferred option)
- QParents App for parents who have signed up – select the payment option.
- No credit card payments are able to be processed over the phone. For all credit card payments contact the BPoint Interactive Voice Response (IVR) 1300-631 073.

The Semester 1 payment due date is Friday 4 March 2022 and Semester 2 due date is Friday 22 July 2022. Parents are welcome to make payment plans by contacting the Business Manager, Donna Fredrickson on dfred3@eq.edu.au Refunds may be applied for and are at the discretion of the School Business Manager.

Annual Payment – Prep Student Resource Scheme – (all participants complete a participation agreement form)

- Prep Resource Scheme - \$120 – per PREP student which includes contribution to STEAM Program, the Arts and eLearning

Annual Payment – Years 1 to 6 students only

- STEAM Payment - \$75 per student includes:
 - eLearning Resources including Mathletics, Education Perfect, ABC Reading Eggs, Oliver Library access from home, Typing tournament, Cospaces, APPS and software to support learning in all curriculum areas
 - Maths and Science Resources including consumables, Museum registration, subsidising Mathematics and Science incursions/excursions
 - Art Resources - class visual arts program

Annual Payment – All Instrumental Music students in Years 3 to 6

- \$125 - for all students in the Instrumental Music Program **hiring a school instrument;**
- \$45 - for all students in the Instrumental Music Program **with own instrument**

Bi-annual Payment – Year 3 Private Instrumental Music Program

- Private Woodwind or Brass Instrumental Tuition – for participating Year 3 students

Annual Payment - Year 6 students only

- Year 6 Program - **\$190 per student** – Year 6 Leadership Program; Curriculum-related Guest Speakers; Seniors' Shirts; Graduation Book; Awards Ceremony; Puberty Talks and other incidental expenses.

Semester Payment - Incursion/Excursion (as per term calendar)

- Excursions or incursions related to year level educational programs

Individual Invoices

- Gala Days - Years 5 and 6 students only
- School Camps – Years 4, 5 and 6
- District Sports representation
- Extension, Enrichment Programs and Competitions
- Music Excursions/ Camps e.g. Choral fest, Beginner Band Blitz
