This funding will be used to

- Increase to 90% of students achieve an A to C in English in Prep and Year 1 and 95% of students achieve an A to C in English in Years 2 to 6. Increase to 70% of students achieve an A or B in Prep to Year 2 in English.
- Increase to 98% of students achieve an A to C in Mathematics.
- Increase to 100% of students in Years 3 and 5 achieving the National Minimum Standard in all aspects of NAPLAN literacy and numeracy.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving in the U2B in Year 3 NAPLAN to 75% for all aspects of literacy and 60% in Numeracy.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving in the U2B in Year 5 NAPLAN to 65% for all aspects of literacy and 70% in Numeracy

Our initiatives include

- Continue to develop a deep understanding of the Australian Curriculum English and deepen teachers' repertoire of effective teaching strategies for the teaching of Reading and Writing.
- Continue to develop a deep understanding of the Australian Curriculum Mathematics and deepen teachers' repertoire of effective teaching strategies for the teaching of Mathematics.
- Build teacher capability in targeted teaching through the careful analysis of school-wide data sets and student work samples to inform next steps for teaching writing (case management, data placemat and moderation)

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Implementing a whole school approach to the teaching of Writing with a focus on formative assessment and feedback to enable all students to succeed in English and Mathematics
 - Employment of a Head of Curriculum to lead the full implementation of the Australian Curriculum and to build staff capability in the teaching of Writing. (\$147200)
 - Employment of a Mathematics Enrichment Teacher to build staff understanding of, and capability in delivery of the Australian Curriculum Mathematics (\$25000)
 - Teacher release each term to build capability in analysing student progress to inform planning in the Australian Curriculum English. (\$14500)
 - Implementation of additional support with teaching assistants for all Year Levels. (\$34730)
 - Purchase of resources to support Tier 2 Literacy Support (\$2216)
